File-Folder set up- Make as many copies of the uppercase and lowercase alphabet sheets as you need. Glue one of each on the inside of the file folder. For the other sheets, cut out the letters and place them in individual envelopes. Take out a few letters and Glue one of the case file labels on the cover of the envelop. The File-Folder title and pieces pouch will be glued to the front cover. You can store the envelopes in the pieces pouch when not using the game. The directions can be glued onto the back of the file-folder.

Challenge- To challenge your students, the letters that you take out can be a sight word that they are learning. After they have determined the missing letters they can try to find out what the missing word is.

Tip- To make the game more motivating you can have magnifying glasses that the students use when discovering the missing letter.

Directions

Help Frog solve the case of the missing letters by matching each of the letters in the case file to the alphabet chart. After you have placed all of the letters you can see which letters are missing.
